Is responsible for all policing services on the five First Nations that make up the Lesser Slave Indian Regional Council Territory, which runs along the Lesser Slave Lake.

Works closely with these communities to prevent and solve crime and police officers work closely with First Nation community members to promote safety and protect their communities.



## Employment with LRPS

Employment standards are set by the Alberta Solicitor General and are the same as all self-administered police service in Alberta.

### Constable-Investigator

Priority may be given to persons applying who have recent police experience (within the last 2 years) with a recognized police service. Those applying without recent police experience will have to meet all the recruit requirements as per the Alberta Police Recruit Selection Standards and meet all the training requirements as per the Edmonton Police Service Training Police for recruits. All applicants must meet security clearance requirements.
